2. Category 3 animal by-products shall be treated in the oven at a temperature of  $\geq 90^{\circ}\text{C}$  .
3. The pet food shall be sampled quarterly at the cooling area to verify compliance with the microbiological standards in Chapter II, paragraph 5 of Annex XIII of Regulation No. 142/2011 .
